He is Co-Founder of HeartWood Centre for Community Youth Development, Halifax; Lead Developmental Evaluator, YouthScape of the J.W. McConnell Family Foundation, Montreal and Associate, Social Innovation Generation, University of Waterloo.

HeartWood engages young people in the renewal of neighbourhoods, schools, agencies and organizations. YouthScape is a national initiative developing strategies for building resilient communities by engaging marginalized young people.

Marc is a graduate of Masters of Management, McGill/McConnell Program for National Voluntary Sector Leaders. This program brought together 120 senior and emerging leaders from non-profit organizations across Canada to study and apply contemporary perspectives to complex challenges in the voluntary sector and in the larger society.

Marc believes that the meaningful involvement of young people in decision making at many levels is essential to building strong communities. Marc and YOU youth leaders will present an inspiring vision for how a Café, fueled by young people, is a true part of building a downtown of hope, connection and caring.
